Parks & Beaches Doe Lake Park

Doe Lake Municipal Park 1014 Ferguson Rd., Katrine

Beautiful beach with public washrooms, covered pavilion with picnic tables and charcoal BBQs. Paved boat launch, playground, basketball and volleyball nets. *Water is quite shallow, so it is better for wading/playing in the water.

20 min. south, near Huntsville. A great place to spend the day! There are beaches, hiking and walking trails. Canoe, kayak and bike rentals also available.

Algonquin Provincial Park

45-60 min away, depending which entrance you go to. Many things to do in this expansive park! Canoe and bicycle rentals available. Visitor Centre with a museum, café, an outdoor Logging Museum trail and the Algonquin Art Centre. Other restaurants in the park as well.

Limberlost Forest and Wildlife Reserve www.limberlostforest.com Open 9 - 5 daily :: 705-635-1584 This private forest reserve contains more than 70 km of scenic views of lakes waterfalls and lookouts on trails designed for hiking, biking, skiing and snowshoeing. This reserve is free of charge to the public.

Mikisew Provincial Park www.ontarioparks.com/park/mikisew

Three beaches, hiking trails and canoe rentals. You can also bring your four-legged friend to the fenced dog area and beach.

Oxtongue River-Ragged Falls Provincial Park

Hwy 60, Dwight - just before Algonquin Park, on the left side of the highway. Hike up the spectacular falls and also canoe the river below. *Rentals through Algonquin Outfitters

Park to Park Trail Location: Access off of 1695 Emsdale Rd. Emsdale

The Park to Park Trail stretches from Algonquin Provincial Park to Killbear Provincial Park. This trail system has a total distance of over 230 km and welcomes both motorized and non-motorized travel. This trail is a four season trail offering access to snowmobiles in the winter.
